- Team Tray is based on “the Common Work Area”™, where dentist and assistant work areas overlap, perfectly accessible to each team member.
- The dentist desk, team tray, and assistant’s support area function as dedicated cockpits for dentist and assistants. These cockpits meet at the syringe/suction holder in the instrument transfer area.
- By rotating the patient's chair, the operator is able to work in all o'clock positions, maintaining Team Tray access without tray movement and, at the same time, reducing operator travel.
- Because the Team Tray does not need to move laterally, the adjacent spaces along the 12 o’ clock wall are available for other useful purposes, such as the dentist's desk/mini-lab area and the assistant’s generous support areas (instead of being consumed by a moving tray or cart).
- The Dentist Desk/Mini-Lab area adjacent to the Team Tray is ideal for examining diagnostic records and patient charts and grinding on dental materials at chairside. An optional x-ray viewer bracket with slides positions viewer from the desk area to operating reference position for comfortable close-range viewing.
- Assistant’s counter provides generous work surfaces to support long appointments and/or multiple procedures.
- High use syringe/suction are located in the perfect position for the dental team.
- The patented tubing management system is free of tangling and tubing tug and provides a simple, maintenance free solution.
- An optional monitor arm provides operator and/or assistant convenient access to view monitor.
- Aerosol-protected smooth-functioning dispenser systems for towels, masks, gloves, cups and tissues in both dentist and assistant preparation areas reduce clutter and support the best possible experience for the dental team, while offering the patient needed reassurances about sanitary process and efficiency.
- Counter contours and heights, sink locations and storage cabinets facilitate specific and desired work patterns for the assistant and dentist without the compromises inherent in a ‘so-called left/right flexible environment that makes the incorrect assumption the assistant’s needs are the same as the operator’s.
- This environment supports the integration of air abrasive units, curing lights, intra oral cameras, nitrous oxide and a full range of high tech components, computer monitors and keyboards.
